Buildings and Yard Equipment

Here's what's happened around the track:

- Installed 80 feet of steel rail on NW corner of the mainline.

- Planted many, many trees.

- Rerouted the derail stub to make clearance for the new sidewalk. (Dan Simmons, Bob Knoecker, Jeff Mills)

- Cleaned tree debris out of the parking lot area.
- Cleaned area around the gravel hopper. (Jim McDermot)

- Checked passenger and wheelchair cars for clearance on the derail grade crossing.

- Installed pegboard for tool storage in the Thomson Bldg.

- Used a concrete planer to work one section of rail on the derail grade crossing to try and ensure clear passage for all of our locomotives and rail cars.

Removed debris left from the wooden bookshelf removal. (Thanks Greg Bright).
Replaced two track panels in the derail stub in preparation for the concrete sidewalk install.

- Set forms to pour the middle 50ft section of the 5 ft wide sidewalk between the depot and the Thomson building.

Upcoming Plans:

- Continue replacing worn out aluminum rail sections with steel rail.

- Replace aluminum frogs with steel frogs as they become available.
- Paint and apply graphics to the 600 series passenger cars.

- Construct a 5 ft. wide sidewalk from the depot to the Thomson building to enhance safe movement for seniors and persons with disabilities. (In Progress)

Our new track and infrastructure projects are really starting to pick up steam. Come on out and get involved!

Engineers Caution! We have planed the concrete at the derail grade crossing to try and ensure clearance for our equipment but I suggest having a spotter available to watch your locomotive and cars as you cross the new Derail Concrete Grade Crossing for the first time to make sure your locomotive and consist has adequate clearance and will not make contact with the concrete. Please take it slow and be careful.



"On Track"

Finally the weather is trending toward warmer and dryer days, which is good for our plans for the new mainline extension project. The final grading should be getting started in March, and after that we can survey the right-of-way and start fabricating new switches and the diamond crossing. We have placed another order for steel rail, which is expected to arrive in April. Later in the Summer we can be moving ahead with laying the new track.

One thing I want everyone to know: using the rail bending tool that Ken Olsen built for us, I've made two steel rails 'radius control pieces' and painted them bright orange on the ends and middle. Please don't use those rails for repair or building new track panels, I need them for checking the alignment of the new right-of-way.

Meanwhile, the existing track will be getting tuned up for the start of our season. Thanks to the dedicated members who have devoted so much time and energy to replacing worn out aluminum rail with new steel rail, there isn't a great deal of trimming required. Through their efforts, the KLS main line is in great shape and just about ready for the Easter Egg run at the end of March.


